The Fox's Trot

What is evangelism? Quite simply it is telling others about Jesus, sharing your faith, inviting people to worship, Bible study, or small groups.

We are a congregation of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America. Evangelical is in our name. Many early American Lutheran churches had the name Evangelical in their names. My last parish was Daniels Evangelical Lutheran Church. Though Evangelical is in our name, it is not to be confused with what has become known as the Evangelical Church, which seems to be the hot topic out of Washington, swaying politicians one way and condemning them if they go in another. Our evangelical has everything to do with sharing the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the world and nothing to do with American politics. We're going to love like Jesus no matter what a political party might say we can or cannot do.

Enough about politics and the Evangelicals. Let's talk about our role in God's Kingdom – evangelism. When we start in church, we may very well believe that the church is here for my benefit. We say things that make it clear that we do not like things if they do not fit our personal needs. Yet, as we mature in our faith we understand that church is not about us personally. Yes, we are a part of the church. However, we are not at the center. We are church for the sake of our neighbor. We are church for the sake of our community. We are church for the sake of the world.

I have been asked by many on how we can grow our church. I don't think any of you like my answer. In part because it takes lots of work. First, it takes all of our members to commit to being evangelists. I'm not asking for you to stand on the street corner with a megaphone. But if you don't start inviting people to become a part of this faith community, they are never going to come. At the beginning of every Christmas program for our school I invited all the families, that were not already committed to a church, to join us on Sunday mornings for worship – and none came. The reason is because people want a personal invite. They want people, who love Gloria Dei, to share with them why Gloria Dei makes a difference in their lives and then invite them to join the experience. Only

you can do that. Begin with your family and friends and expand from there. The only way to get people into worship is by you, the members of Gloria Dei, sharing your story and inviting them to come.

Second, it takes discipleship. I don't care how long you have been in the church, we all need time for prayer, Bible study, and fellowship with other Christians. Some of this can be done on your own, but it is better in a group. One of the number one factors for church growth is small groups. It has been this way since the 80s and has not changed for 40 years. Now, we may call them something different today so it doesn't sound like we are living in the 80s; but essentially getting a group of 5 to 10 people together for a weekly gathering of prayer, Bible study, and fellowship grows churches. If you're not praying and reading God's word, you are not in a small group that will grow the church. Fellowship alone is not enough. Unless we have a handful of people to step up to facilitating small groups, this will remain dormant. I am happy to do training sessions with a handful of you and then send you out to pray for, invite, and facilitate weekly small groups. Small groups rely solely on volunteers, not pastors to lead—though I will be here to walk you through the process and check-in monthly with how things are going.

Third, it takes outreach. Service projects should be built into every ministry of Gloria Dei. By reaching out into the community to help people with their struggles and needs, we circle back to evangelism through actions rather than words. In outreach, we show people Jesus. In evangelism, we tell people about Jesus. Outreach takes intentionality and loads of people jumping on board to make a difference on Fox Hill Road.

These are your key three ministries to growing the church, and it all starts and ends with evangelism. To begin this journey, I want you to take time to pray. Pray that God might open your heart and mind as to who you can begin to invite to be a part of the Gloria Dei community. With time you will realize that you can invite anyone – that may take a bit of time though. Pray and discern about facilitating a small group. And pray about how we as a congregation can show our community Jesus through the works of our hands. Without evangelism, discipleship, and outreach expect things to stay more or less the same. Every one of you are capable of growing Gloria Dei. Pray as if everything depends on God. Work as if everything depends on you.
